Seeds are crucial for empowering farmers to address various agricultural challenges, by enabling gain in crop productivity, enhancing livelihood and ensuring food and nutrition security. In India, producing and distributing quality, affordable seeds tailored to agro-climatic zones significantly boosts agriculture. The seed system, involving public and private agencies, is continuously evolving to meet the needs of the farmers amid climate change and dynamic market demands. Innovations in seed technology and policy support have spurred the sector's growth, with India's seed market expected to reach US\$ 11.3 billion by 2027, despite its modest global share of 4%.

The National Seed Congress (NSC 2024) is an annual convergence for researchers, experts, policymakers, representatives from the private sector, government officials, farmers, and other stakeholders to discuss critical issues affecting the seed sector. Building on the success of the previous NSC editions in accelerating developments in seed production, policies, delivery channels, and future directions, NSC 2024 will emphasize various seed system innovations, regional cooperation, seed policy, community engagement in seed delivery, seed entrepreneurship, crop improvement, use of digital innovations and more. NSC 2024 will bring a global perspective to the Indian seed industry, planning for its sustained growth and strengthening its competitive and evolving landscape.

- Create a platform for different stakeholders from the seed sector to share and exchange innovations curated around different domains of seed systems in India
- Reflecting on the system's capacity and priorities to meet the emerging needs of the seed sector

- Formulate a roadmap for sustainable growth of the seed sector in India




About NSRTC

The National Seed Research and Training Centre (NSRTC) is the apex institution for maintaining uniformity in seed testing and human resource development at the national level. NSRTC oversees State Seed Testing Laboratories and addresses their challenges. It educates and empowers seed entrepreneurs through national training programs, workshops, and the National Seed Congress. The NSRTC was established to have a separate National Seed Quality Control Laboratory, which serves as the Central Seed Testing Laboratory (CSTL) for maintaining uniformity in seed testing results among all State Seed Testing Laboratories nationwide. As a member of the International Seed Testing Association (ISTA), CSTL is working towards ISTA accreditation to ensure India's seed industry remains globally competitive.

About the Venue:

The 13th National Seed Congress will be organized in Varanasi, U.P. which is unique in several ways. Several Indian Council of Agricultural Research (ICAR) and state-level centers of excellence are located in U.P. and around Varanasi.
